Investment strategy

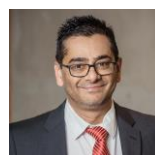

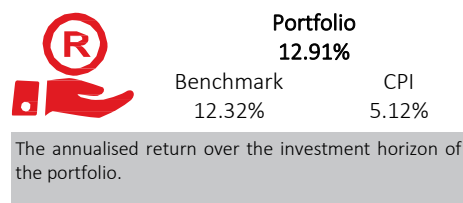

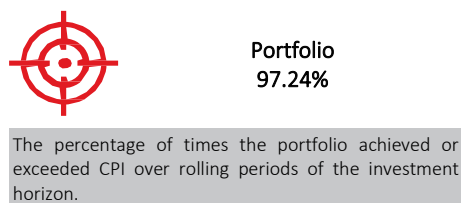

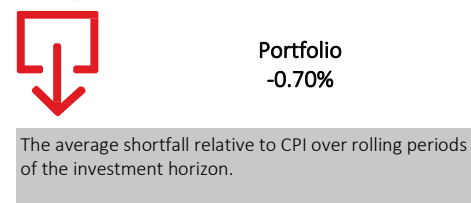
Return over the investment horizon



Hit rate

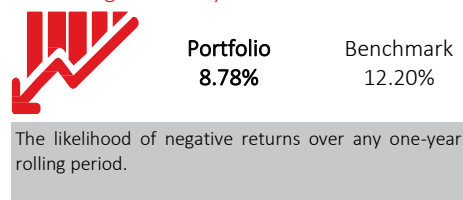


Average shortfall

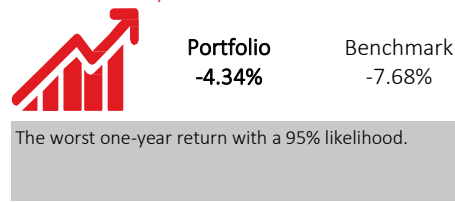


Short-term risk

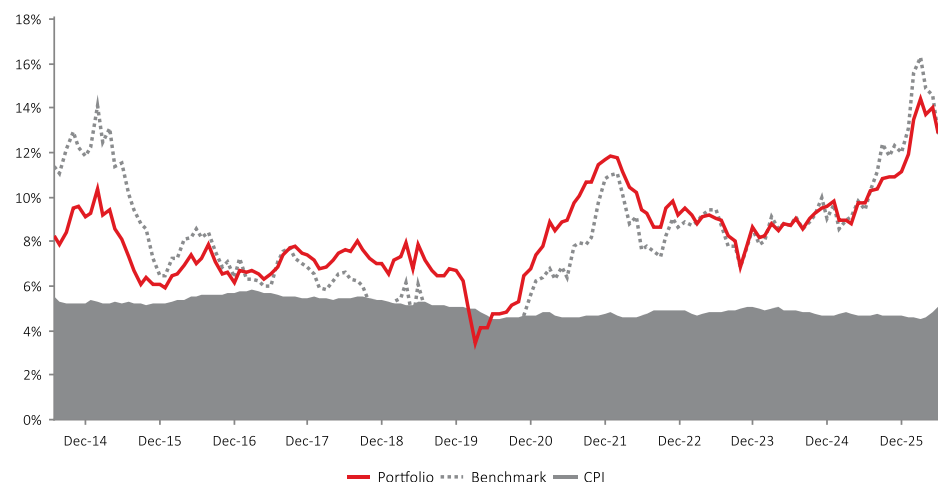
Risk of negative one-year return

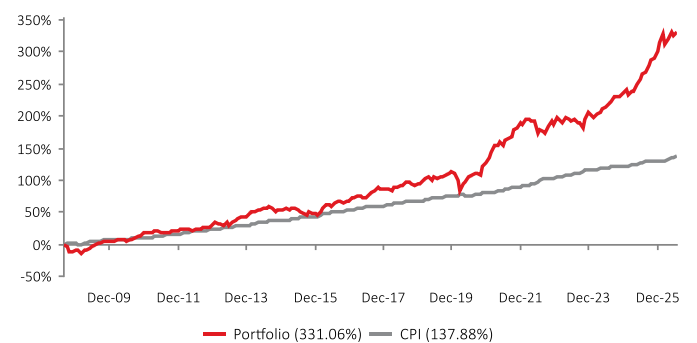

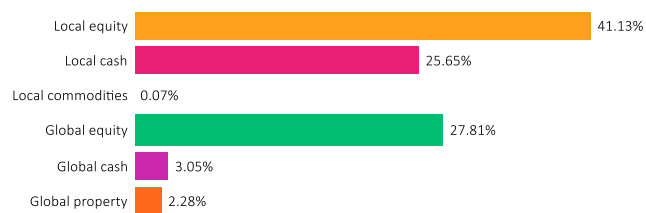

The Momentum GLA Shari'ah Portfolio invests 100% in the Momentum Investments Shari'ah Portfolio.

On 1 September 2025 changes were made to the strategic asset allocations/composite benchmark.

On 1 August 2021 changes were made to the strategic asset allocations/composite benchmark.

On 1 January 2021 the real return expectation for this portfolio was revised from inflation plus 5% over 4-year rolling periods to inflation plus 4% over 6-year rolling periods.

After careful consideration, Momentum Outcome-based Solutions decided to adopt the FTSE/JSE Shari'ah All Share Index as the benchmark for the equity component of this portfolio from 1 April 2013. The company feels this is more appropriate, given the nature of the portfolio as well as the investable opportunities available to its equity managers.



Disclosures

The investment policy is underwritten by Momentum Metropolitan Life Limited, which is a registered insurer under the Insurance Act, 18 of 2017. This investment portfolio is administered and managed by Momentum Multi-Manager (Pty) Ltd, an authorised financial services provider (FSP No. 19840) under the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act No.37 of 2002 (FAIS Act), as may be amended and/or replaced from time to time, and a part of Momentum Group Limited, rated B-BBEE level 1.

All returns quoted are before deduction of fees, but after the deduction of performance fees on global underlying investments (where applicable). All returns are daily time-weighted returns.
